
Echeveria oswaldiana Reyes & Islas, sp. nov.

Holotype: Colombia. Málaga [Dept. Santander]: Málaga, Loc. Quebrada del Guamo, road between Bucaramanga and Málaga, 1800 m, 4.VIII. 2024, J. Reyes, A. Islas, O. Anguiano, D. Giraldo-Cañas, A. Bohórquez Joya, H. Largo, JE-9532 COL![COL-635100].

Echeveria oswaldiana; *E. coccineae* (Cavanilles) De Candolle affinis sed caulibus brevioribus 24 cm (vs. 80 cm), foliis violaceis (vs. rubro-viridibus), pedicellis usque ad 5 cm longis (vs. 2 cm), corolla bicolori (vs. unicolori), carpellis flavo-roseis, maculatis (albis, concoloribus), nectariis lunatis, roseis (vs. reniformibus, albis) differt (2).

Description

Pubescent, perennial plant. *Stems* 12–24 cm tall, 0.5–1 cm in diameter. *Rosette* lax, 10–14 cm diameter, *leaves* ascending to spreading, pubescent, green–violaceous, lanceolate to oblong, upper face concave, leaf margin entire, ciliate, 7.5–8.5 cm long, 2–2.3 cm wide, apex acute. *Flowering stem* pubescent, 30–46 cm tall, including inflorescence, 0.5–0.6 cm thick near base; inflorescence racemose with 22–24 flowers, flowering stem leaves (3) ascending to spreading, lanceolate, apex acute, 3–4 cm long, 0.7–1 cm wide, green–violaceous. *Pedicels* 3–5 mm long, ca. 2 mm thick, 2–3 bractlets filiform to lanceolate 5–12 mm long, 2–4 mm wide, pubescent. Calyx discoid (4) *sepals* unequal, green, ascending, lanceolate to filiform, 1–1.2 cm long, 2–3 mm wide, apiculate. Corolla subcylindrical, pentagonal, 10–12 mm long, ca. 7 mm thick near base, red with yellow tip, *petals* elliptic to oblanceolate, cuspidate, keeled outside, concave and yellow inside.
