

Echeveria 'Pinky'

Parentage: *E. subrigida* x *E. shaviana*

Stemless, offsets few or none except in age, forms a dense rosette 15cm diameter or more of crowded, thinish, pruinose leaves. They are spatulate, flat above, rounded beneath, terminating in a slender point, blueish-green with an overlay of pink bloom, margins deep pink, thin, narrow and crimped.
Flowers: The inflorescence is a raceme with reddish flowers

Origin. U.S.A. Deliberate cross by Myron Kinnach of the Huntington Botanical Gardens California 1961. distributed and recorded on the 1971. IST list N°697.
Remarks. This is a very distinctive and decorative hybrid that should be included in all collections, It comes nearest to *E. shaviana* but differs in its flat leaves and larger more colourful rosette of blue and pink not grey leaves.
