

Echeveria 'Mutabilis'

Selenil

Parentage. *E. linguaeifolia* x *E. Scheseri*
E. linguaeifolia x *E. expatriata*. Walther.

Stem evident, 10 to 30cm tall branching, topped with a lax rosette of yellowish green leaves, they are spatulate, 5cm long, 2cm broad, thick, concave above with thickened margins.

Flowers. The inflorescence is decumbent, laxly branching 15 to 75cm long with numerous pale yellowish-green flowers. Flowers, February - March.

Origin. France. Short description in Mons Selenil Catalogue for 1874. Description by Walther, *Cactus & Succulent Journal of America* Vol VIII 1937 N° 11.

Remarks. The true parents have never been confirmed for this hybrid, but the influence of *E. linguaeifolia* as one of them is unmistakable in the decumbent inflorescence. Although one of the least decorative of the recorded hybrids, it appears to be very well distributed.
