

Echeveria 'TINGDENE'.

Cannithon.

Parentage. *E. subrigida* x *E. affinis*

Plants glabrous, stem thick but short, rosettes to 13cm in diameter or more, offsets few or none. The brownish green leaves are crowded, thick, turgid, not at all glaucous, 6cm long 2 to 3cm broad, shallowly concave above, rounded beneath, upcurved towards the tip.

Flowers. The inflorescence is short with a few orange-pink urn shaped flowers. Flowers from August on.

Origin. This hybrid is a sister seedling to *E. Phyllis Collis*, first recorded in the N.C.E.S.S. journal Vol 33/1. 1978.

Remarks: When young this hybrid is similar in growth to *E. affinis*, it differs in having brownish-green leaves, a larger rosette and pink not red flowers.
