## An annotated checklist of the infragenera of *Agave* L.

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*No new names or type designations are proposed in this paper*

### **Summary**

The present paper attempts to list all known infrageneric divisions of *Agave* L. (114) with their status under the present rules, together with their etymology and typification. 45 species of *Agave* L. are types and are listed alphabetically together with the valid and legitimate infrageneric names that have been applied to them, in chronological order.

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## An annotated checklist of the infragenera of *Agave* L.

Species of the genus *Agave* L. divide naturally into those with an unbranched inflorescence (spicate) and those that branch at the top, bearing bunches of flowers at the ends of each branch (paniculate). Since agaves do not reach floral maturity until late in life, this division was not noticed by many early botanists who consequently classified mainly on leaf characters.

The earliest segregate was *Littaea geminiflora* Tagl. in 1812. It was at first thought to belong with *Dracaena* or *Yucca*, but Tagliabue himself surmised that it lay somewhere between *Agave* L. and *Yucca* L. However, the new genus he had created was soon absorbed into *Agave* L. in 1817 by the Kew botanist Ker Gawler, who was quick to recognise its true affinity.

The earliest infrageneric classification of the genus *Agave* L. was provided by Prince Salm-Dyck, who recognised five sections based on leaf form only.

J. G. Baker of Kew gave the fullest classification of the 19thC, using a mixture of floral and vegetative characters. He was also the first to publish rankless infrageneric names called “groups”, a now out-dated fashion which has strangely been continued into modern times. New group names since 1 Jan 1953 are of course invalidly published (Art. 37.1). However, Gentry (1982) did indicate that his own groups were “sectional” on p.62 of his monograph, so he has been given the benefit of the doubt with regard to ranking here.

Unfortunately, this is academic because he also forgot to provide or refer to Latin diagnoses.

Of the larger generic segregates, *Littaea* Tagl., *Manfreda* Salisb. and *Polianthes* L. have been shown to be embedded in the genus *Agave* L. according to two molecular studies, so are here included.

The taxonomic literature on *Agave* has been somewhat cryptic, being mostly buried in rare obsolete journals, and a full bibliography of taxonomic works has been lacking until now.

### The generic name

*Agave* L., *Species plantarum* 1: 323-324. (1 May) 1753 & *Genera plantarum* (ed.5): 150. (Aug) 1754 [Both treated as having been published simultaneously on 1 May 1754 (Art. 13.4)].

*Etym:* A name created by Linnaeus in *Hortus upsalensis* (1748: 88), with the explanation: “Not having had an earlier or ancient name, it is called *Agave* on account of it being a plant worthy of admiration.” A feminine first declension noun formed from the Greek adjective *ágauós*, illustrious or noble. Not, however, named for Agave, the daughter of Kadmos, mother of Pentheus, in Greek mythology, as some writers have speculated.

*T:* Not cited. Included four species in the protologue, although when the name had been first proposed five years earlier it included only *Agave americana* L.

*LT:* *Agave americana* L. The first formal designation was by N. L. Britton & P. Wilson, Descriptive flora, in N. L. Britton, *Scientific survey of Porto Rico and the Virgin Islands* 5(1): 156. (10 Aug) 1923.

*Etym:* Unarmed agave. For the absence of leaf-margin spines.

*T:* Not cited.

*Obs:* Includes *Inermes* Jacobi, *Subinermes* Jacobi pro parte, *Serrulatae* Baker & *Attenuatae* Baker.

**Antillanae** Trel. (pro infragen. *Agave* L. as “group”), *Agave* in the West Indies, *Memoirs of the National Academy of Sciences* 11: 9, 29. 1913.

*Etym:* From the Greater Antilles, to which they are mainly endemic.

*T:* *Agave antillarum* Descourt.

**Antillanae** (Trel.) A.Berger (pro ser. *Agave* L.), *Die Agaven*: 22, 25, 26, 205. (Oct-Nov) 1915.

*Etym:* Herbaceous and fleshy.

*T:* Not cited.

*Obs:* Includes the type of *Manfreda* Salisb. (1866, pro gen.).

***Caulescentes*** Salm-Dyck (pro infragen. *Agave* L.), *Index plantarum succulentarum in horto Dyckensi cultarum. Anno 1829:* 3. 1829; *Hortus Dyckensis:* 7. 1834 nom. nud.

*Etym:* Becoming stemmed.

*Etym*: Smoke-like.
